Difficulty Level: Intermediate

Techniques/Prerequisites: Peyote stitch, tubular peyote stitch, netting

Kits are \$48 and available in 4 colorways Instruction cost for a 6 hour class is \$75 for guild members and \$95 for non-members

Build a glorious beaded flower showcasing a transparent 25mm glass doublet adorned with a stunning teardrop chandelier pendant in its own bezel. This project celebrates peyote stitch and color with its flower motif and stunning seed beads!

Herculez Thread Review

Pros

- The 6lb I purchase is much thinner than 6lb Fireline. More passes thru the beads would be doable
- It would drape really dangles
- Color does not come off on hands
- Comes in a range of weighs, spool sizes and colors (available at Amazon.com)

Cons

- 6lb Fireline is .006" (.1524mm) vs 6lb Hercules which is .003" (.08mm)
- It does not melt or burn, if you would like it to.



Updates from Bead Retreats

Bead Fest (Maker's Fest)

This year, there was beading, fiber arts and metalwork. Teachers weren't allowed to sell kits in their classes, but the shopping was good.

Jackson BeadFest

In its first year, there were 12 classes which took place in an art/dance studio. Classes had 4 to 14 students. Kits were expensive, but parking was easy. For shopping, there were about 12 vendors, most selling focal points (cabochons, charms, etc.). The town of Jackson was quiet.









Choosing Colors for Your Beadwork

If you already have a colorful cabochon or focal bead chosen for your next beadwork design, then you're well on your way to picking your color palette. Choose colors that are in the same color family as the colors in your focal bead or cabochon. If you're starting from scratch, you can find color palettes from multiple sources online or you can make you own color palettes based on things you love, like a favorite photo, work of art, or dress

- 1. Take inspiration from a focal bead or cabochon.
- 2. Search "Color Palettes" on Pinterest.
- 3. Use the website <u>Design Seeds</u> to find color palettes.
- 4. Take your own color inspiration from a photo, an article of clothing or anything you like the look of.
